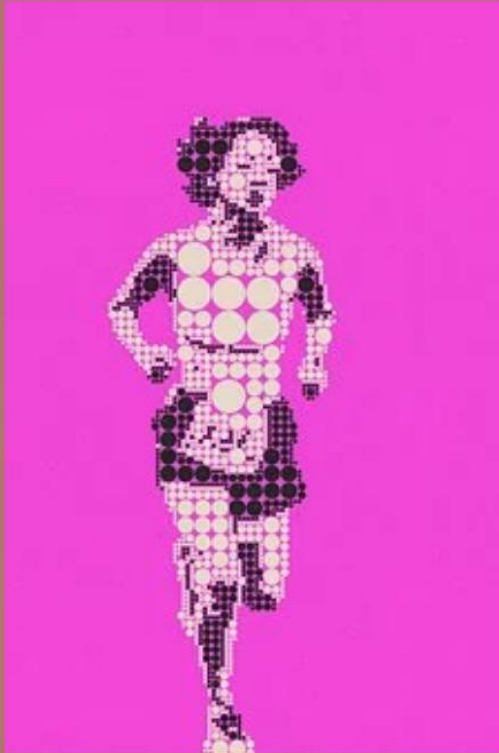

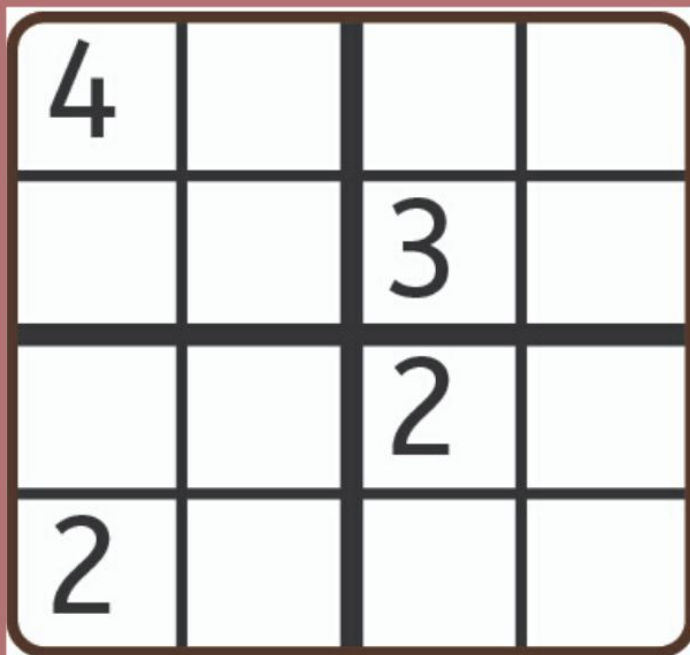
Symbol Zone

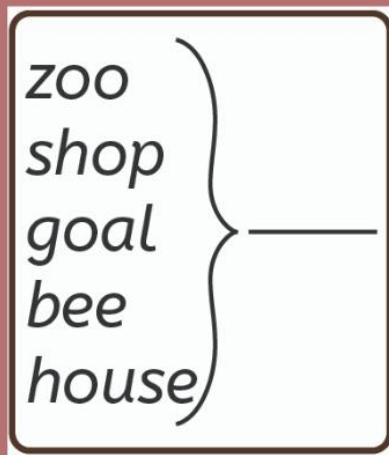
