



Week 3: Set 1 - Cards 6-10

### Introduction

For those of you who have not tried CardED before, CardEd is a simple and easy-to-use resource, designed to develop and reinforce a range of knowledge and skills and suitable for children across a span of age ranges.

During these Covid-19 school closures, Dumond has made our entire CardEd range FREE to download from our shop. This includes sets 1 - 4 cards, the accompanying activity guide, our CardEd Workbooks, and our CardEd apps (available to download in the Play Store now).

To support you in using the cards at home, we will regularly post a card together with activity suggestions and ideas suitable for children of a mix of ages. Some of the thinking challenges in our CardEd Workbooks may even stump parents and carers!

To begin with, familiarising yourself with the CardEd layout is helpful (see next page). CardEd cards are divided into 6 zones, and I relate the activities to particular ones. If you would like further suggestions for using the cards, our accompanying Bumper Activity Guide is packed full of general ideas.

You will notice the tasks are suitable for children of various ages. You may find your older children enjoy undertaking some of these activities with their younger siblings.


In addition to being useful for upper primary children, our CardEd Workbooks are a brilliant resource for students learning English as an Additional Language (EAL).




#### CardEd Layout

All CardEd sets have the same layout with 6 zones as shown below.





## CardEd Set 1, Card 6 Activity Ideas

#### Colour Zone

Word Zone

- Identify the card colour.
- How many red foods can your child name in 5 minutes?
- How many words containing -red can your child think of?

#### Letter Zone

- Identify the letter on the card.
- What sound(s) can it represent?
- How many verbs (action words) beginning with e can you think of?
- How many adjectives (describing words) beginning with e can you think of?

- Read the words.
- Think of a rhyming word to go with each word.
  What is the plural of foot?
- List as many words as possible containing ough. What do you notice about their pronunciation?
- Younger children should think of words containing oo and contrast their pronunciations.

#### Symbol Zone

- Identify the symbol.
- Add up all the letters on the card.
- Write 5 sums that add up to this total.




## CardEd Set 1, Card 6 Activity Ideas

**Number Zone** 

Mathematics/Image Zone

- Identify the number on the card.
- What number comes before or after it?
- If I share something between 4 people, what fraction does each person get?
- Count in 4s as high as you can go.
- Now, reverse it!
- Can you think of an efficient way to multiply by 4?
- What are the four seasons?
- Name 4 signs of the season we are now in.
- Can you think of 4 spring flowers?
- Can you think of 4 baby animals born in spring?



Flash the card at your child for 5 seconds and then hide it.


- Can your child draw what was in the image zone?
- Can your child tell you exactly what they saw (yellow triangle etc.)?





- How many places beginning and ending with A think of?

- What is the opposite of full?

#### Number Zone

- Identify the number.
- What is one more and one less than 10?
- Make a set of 10 things that will all fit on a plate.
- What is 10 + 10?
- What is 100 + 10?
- What is 1000 + 10?

Flash the card at your child for 5 seconds and then hide it.

- Can your child draw what they saw?
- How many points on 1 star / 3 stars / 5 stars?
- How many edges on 1 star / 3 stars / 5 stars?



Younger children need not recall this. Looking at the card discuss,

- How many shapes can you see?
- What are they?
- What colours are they?




Mathematics/Image Zone

- Pick an exercise, e.g. star jumps and do it 5 times!


- Can you name the shape?

## CardEd Set 1, Card 10 Activity Ideas


#### Colour Zone

#### Symbol Zone

- Identify the symbol.
- Ask your child to collect 7 small toys. Have them make a set of 6 and close their eyes. Add a toy. Can they tell what you have added?
- Try again with a different number of toys.
- Add up all the numbers on the cards this week
  (4 + 10 + 5 + 7 + 7 = \_\_\_)

#### Letter Zone



- Identify the letter on the card.
- What sound(s) can it represent?
- How many things beginning with 'r' can you spy from where you are sitting?
- Do you know any fictional characters with an 'R' name?
- Ask your child to choose one of their characters and play charades. Can anyone guess who they are?


